The dog should immediately come to the handler defense by biting the suspect and ocntinue biting until called off by the handler. The dog should then cease and return to the handler.

The trainer will hide two suspects in an area not visible to the Dog Team. the team will walk to a predetermined location. The suspect will attempt to make entry into the residence without permission. The dog should approach the suspect and begin to bark. The suspect will then challenge the dog, at which time the dog should bite the suspect. The handler will then enter the room and call of the dog, and regain control.
